

## Guidance for 3-12 Grading During School Closure

Best Case Scenario — The impact on COVID19 on families and students is significant. We cannot predict what would have happened this semester, so we are providing students with a best-case scenario to ensure students are not disadvantaged because of circumstances beyond their control.

Credit or No Credit — 4th Nine Weeks grades will be graded as Credit or No Credit. To provide students with the benefit of the doubt and assume a best-case scenario, a Credit grade is denoted as a 100 and a No Credit grade is denoted as a 69.

## Credit

- Students have adequate mastery of TEKS to be successful next year.
- Students participate in course discussions and activities (synchronously and/or asynchronously).
- Assignments are completed and of an acceptable quality
- Credit grade for 4th Nine Weeks is denoted as a 100.

## No Credit

- Students do not have mastery of 4th Nine Weeks TEKS may not be prepared for next year.
- Students demonstrate minimal participation in course discussions and activities (synchronously and/or asynchronously).
- Minimal course assignments are completed.
- Grade for 4th Nine Weeks is a 69.

- First semester averages remain the same.
- Multiplier calculations remain the same.
