351 - Dinosaur Dig!

Incoming K-2nd grade | \$125 | JoAnne Alverio

Did you know that some dinosaurs had as many as 900 teeth?! Or that a dinosaur tooth fossil was found measuring more than a foot long! Dinosaur Dig is a fun, interactive learning session full of activities that's perfect for the budding young anthropologist and paleontologist! 363 - The Wizarding World of Harry Potter


Incoming 3rd-6th grade | \$150 | Krystine Carni
