# A. Community First Health Plan (Introduction)

#### B. Booster Club Strategic Thinking- Dr. Frank Alfaro

There is a strategic planning process in place with the larger booster clubs at Alamo Heights ISD. Their efforts provide for generous donations to AHISD. A working group is exploring ways to eliminate redundancy and increase efficiency.

#### C. School Safety Presentations to the Community- Dr. Frank Alfaro

The School Safety Presentations to the Community will be held on October 1st, October 3rd, and October 8th (this date will be a Spanish presentation). They will be at Woodridge Auditorium from 5:30-7:30 PM. This is an opportunity for the community to learn about all the things AHISD has done over the years relative to school safety and to provide input from their perspective.
